- Class 300 - Best sheaf of wheat.
- Class 301 - Best sheaf of feeding barley.
- Class 302 - Best sheaf of malting barley.
- Class 303 - Best 4 lbs. of feeding barley.
- Class 304 - Best 3 maize plants for silage.
- Class 305 - Best 3 Swedes, any variety.
- Class 306 - Best sample whole crop silage.
- Class 307 - Best 3 fodder beet.
- Class 308 - Heaviest single fodder beet.
- Class 309 - Heaviest single Swede, any variety.
- Class 310 - Best old permanent grass sod. From a pasture at least 5 years and upwards.
- Class 311 - Best new pasture grass sod 18" by 12".
- Class 312 - Best sample of grass silage.
- Class 313 - Best square bale of hay.
